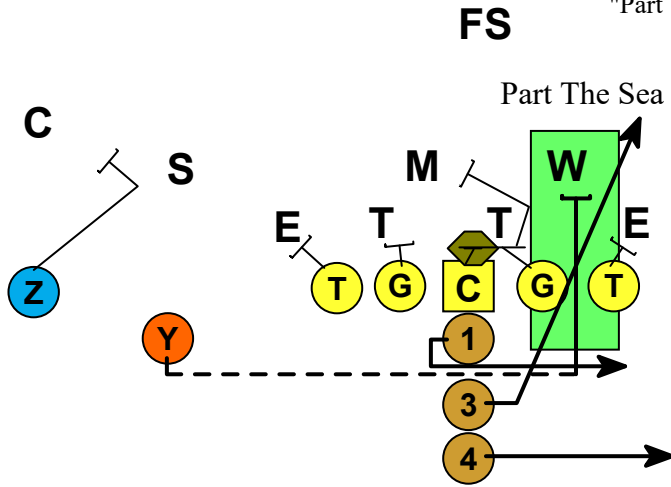

Green Left Tom 34 ISO

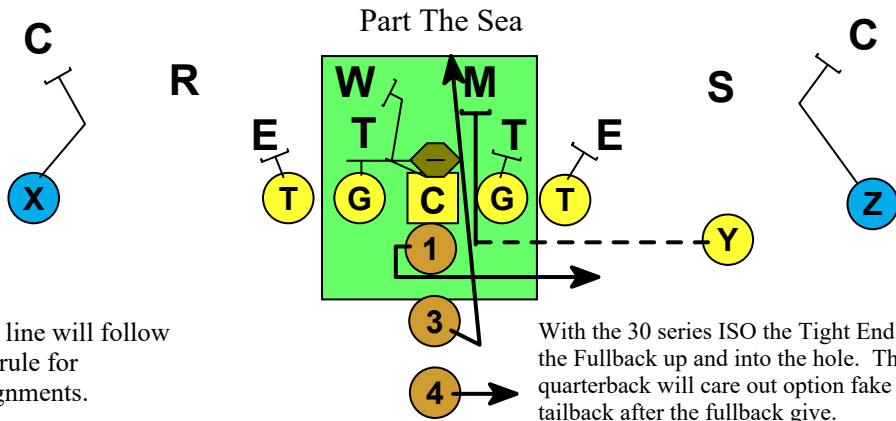
34 - 35 ISO will isolate the playside linebacker. The key coaching term is "Part The Sea" at the point of attack.

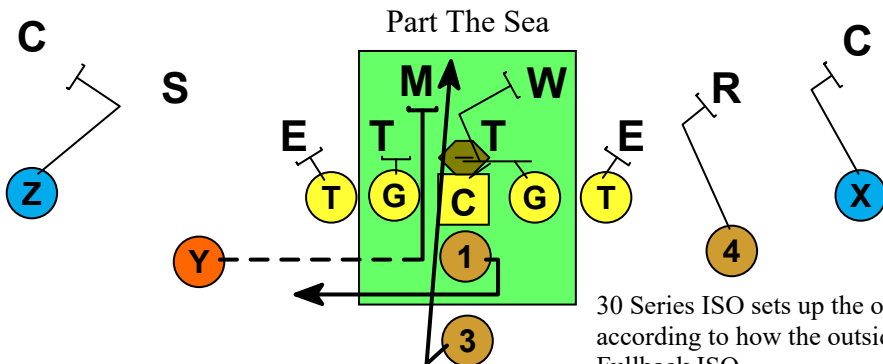

Installing ISO Into Your Offense

Basics

the basics of the isolation play. The play can either be run through the A gap (restricted ISO) or B gap off either side of the center - or it can be run off the guard in the 3 or 4 hole. The difference will be in who is the isolation player. It's called ISO because one of the LBs will be isolated for the FB to block with the other LBs will be blocked with a combo from the OL. If it's run off the center the MIKE will be isolated, otherwise, an OLB can be isolated. ISO is best run in "B" gap.

Phase Three / Numbers 4 & 5 Equals (Part The Sea) ISO's:

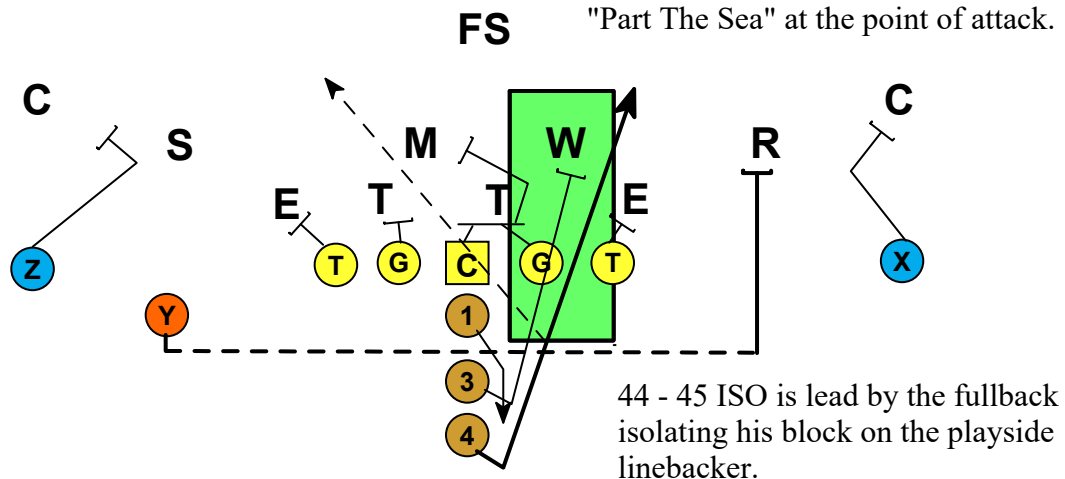
Incorporates a fast zone counter rotating blocking scheme that we use for our ISO plays. Our ISO plays are blocked by using the term "Part The Sea" at the point of attack through the near ear. All ISO plays will be rotated away from the hole and fast rotates our offensive linemen as they track their 2nd level linebackers. Numbers used to counter rotate or part the seas:

Any play called that ends with a 4 or 5 means we are running some type of ISO. We have When running an ISO play the blocking scheme will push back and away from the point of attack this is the reason I use the term part the sea.

Traditional Call: Green Left Tom 44 ISO

No Huddle Hurry-up Call: Illinois (Left) Indiana (Right)

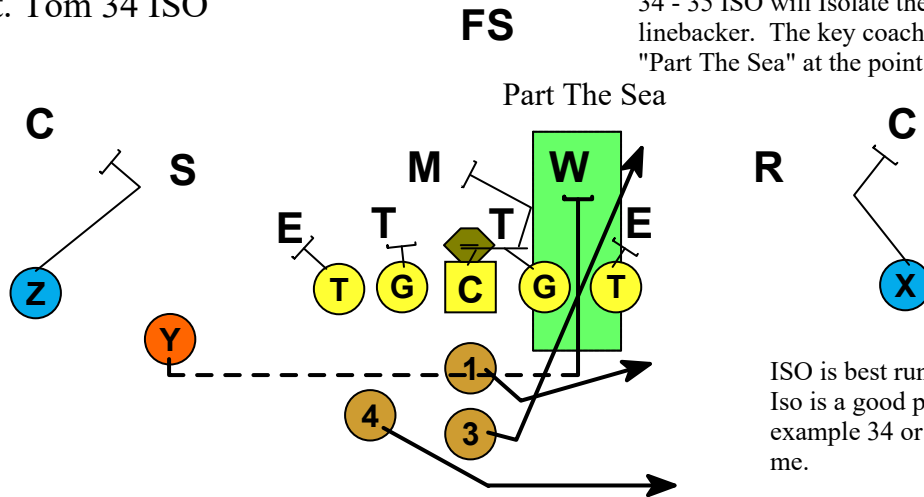

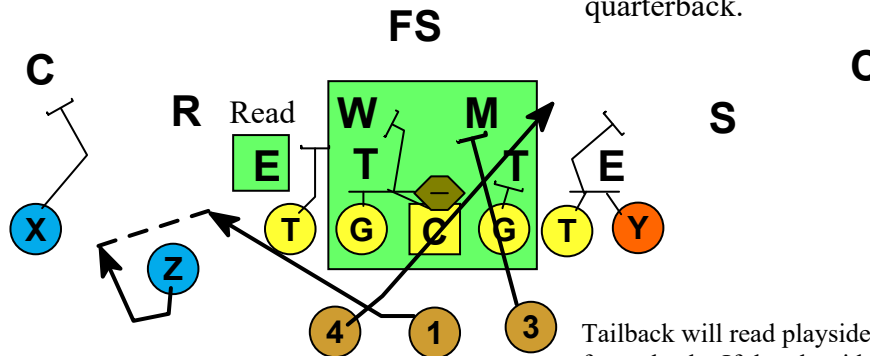
Green Lt Tom 44 ISO

44 - 45 ISO is lead by the fullback isolating his block on the playside linebacker.

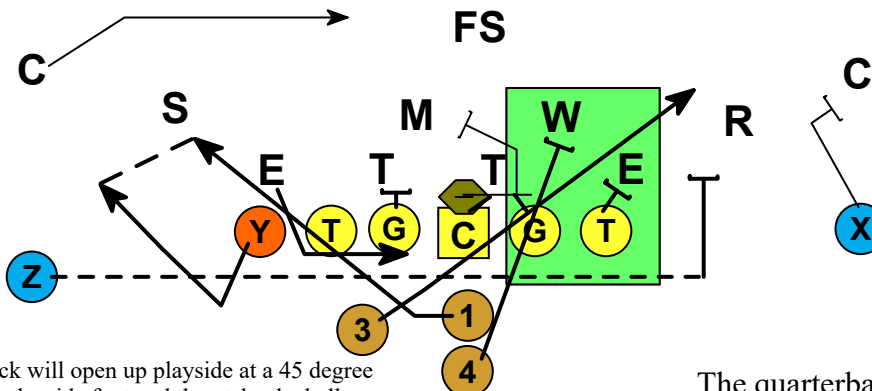
Gun Twins Rt 14 ISO



This is a backside zone read for the quarterback.

Tailback will read playside linebacker for cutback. If the playside linebacker triggers hard then tailback will cut backside of the "V"

Pistol Lt Zip 14 ISO



The quarterback will open up playside at a 45 degree angle with his playside foot and then take the ball straight back to his tailback. Quarterback wants to get the ball back to the tailback as deep as possible.

The quarterback upon handing the ball off will set up and show pass.
