- ▶ **Mandatory weekly in-season staff meetings**
- ▶ **Ride the bus to and from games together**
- ▶ **Spring, summer, and fall practices must be attended by all staff.**
- ▶ **One Glazier Clinic per year.**
- ▶ **Spring camping trip (not mandatory, but a great staff-builder).**
- ▶ **Monthly Coach Club (also not mandatory).**
- ▶ **Attendance to every practice, all practice long.**
- ▶ **Respect for the program is our obligation, not a choice.**
- ▶ **If the football program is going to be better because of our existence, full investment in it is also our obligation.**

Assist with organizing, directing, and implementing all phases of the program, including practice sessions, on campus recruitment, counseling, training, and conditioning.

Assist with directing and coaching the program according to State standards, rules and regulations; adhere to the operating principals, as well as the Code of Ethics for Coaches. Communicate and facilitate an environment where student athletes adhere to the Code of Ethics for Athletes.

Foster

Foster among the participants and spectators an appreciation of the values of athletics, a desire to win, an attitude of good sportsmanship, and a sense of pride in self, team, school, and community.

Assist

Assist with monitoring the academic performance of student-athletes and intervene when expectations are not met by conferring with the head coach, athletic director, teacher(s) and/or parents.

Communicate

Communicate regularly with students, parents, administrators, Associated Student Body, faculty, and high school coaches. Demonstrate awareness, commitment, and adherence to Conference rules.

Work

Work collaboratively with the head coach, athletic director, site principal, faculty, district office staff, and parents utilizing courtesy, tact, and diplomacy.

Establish and maintain effective, cooperative working relationships with those contacted in performance of duties.

Assist with directing the training, conditioning, and performance of the athletic team.

Assist

Assist with the inventory and care of equipment.

Advise

Advise the head coach of the condition of athletic facilities and needs for their preparation and maintenance.

Assist

Assist the head coach and athletic director to ensure that lists of all players eligible for athletic contests are prepared and maintained under rules of the CIF.

Recommend to the head coach and athletic director the removal of athletes from the team when behavior expectations, training, and/or eligibility regulations have not been met.

Assist	Assist the head coach to ensure all fund raising activities are compliant with, Hemet Unified School District and school site policies and CA law.
Assist	Assist the head coach to ensure all student-athletes have been cleared for participation by the athletic director before the regular practice season begins.
Assist	Assist the head coach to advise the athletic director as to the preparation of schedules for his/her respective sport.
Recommended	Recommend to the head coach/athletic director those students who qualify for a varsity letter.
Perform	Perform other duties as assigned by the head coach and/or athletic director.
